

COVID Update

- Low community transmission level as a state
- CDC sees Bennington county as rather high levels, but the rest of the state is pretty green
- We're choosing to view the state as a whole entity and not regions
- Percent positivity rate is skyrocketing, but shouldn't be looked at anymore (means we're not doing enough testing)
- Hospitalizations have gone from the high 30s and are now in the 50s threshold
 - 1/3 of these are because of COVID (not people that come in for something else and then test for COVID)
- 8 or so deaths for month of September (lower than preceding months)
- Vaccine effort is going well about 50,000 bivalent boosters provided
- Continue to be doing well in our age 5 and below vaccines
- Schools remain open with upbeat atmosphere
 - Schools have had a lot of respiratory illness
- Still seeing mostly BA.4 and BA.5 and haven't seen an unexpected true variant
- The state sites that EMS is staffing are providing flu vaccines to those 65 and under
 - Still about 50% of the bivalent boosters
 - Pharmacies are about 30%
 - Healthcare providers are in 10% to low teens

hMPXV

- Inactive in VT and we are working on decommissioning
- Nation is seeing downward trend and are hopeful that will continue
 - Combination of infection, vaccination, and behavior change in high risk populations
- VT still has 3 cases
- Have enough vaccines

Other Respiratory Viruses

• EnterovirusD68, Rhino Virus, etc. - These other viruses are causing other respiratory illnesses

Legionella

- A few clusters at a bed and Breakfast and then in St. Albans
 - No clusters in a few months
- Source hasn't been identified

Cannabis

- May be some individuals that have been using before, and now there may be more new users trying it for the first time
 - Most concerned about kids
- Watch emergency department visits contributed to cannabis use

The NE region is having not a crisis but reaching close to capacity with pediatric ICU and pediatric intake for respiratory illness. Hasn't happened to VT yet but are watching it closely. Going to see a much more robust flu season.

Has there been follow up or what have you been hearing regarding the colored fentanyl, especially with Halloween coming up?

There isn't a real update. The concern is that the product exists at all. Are people in VT going to be aware enough about it/the safety factors? Parents are regulating much more what their kids eat/where they go.

Any update on the updated booster for the pediatric population

Everyone is saying mid-October for actually putting it into kid's arms. Could be any day now to understanding when it will be available. We have pre-ordered from the government and will be sent the moment they can be.
