- Vermont the lowest rate of anywhere in the nation 10 1.5% more tests to give away putting them at home PCR tests can't give away
- 3 outbreaks in the last week 1 in schools 2 in long term care
- India another strain not being transmitted terribly quickly
- Vaccine recommendation that came out last week if you so choose the evidence base is not robust yet.
- FDA has not said there will be another round in the Fall it would be ideal if the flu could be in the at the same time not MRNA yet.

Environmental Health

- PCB testing in schools
 - o PCBS are still on the front burner
 - o about 1/3 of the schools that exceed the school action level immediate action levels can't be used at all until mitigation is done
 - o schools concerned about the costs until remediation
- PFAS family EPA is going to be in that long comment uncharacteristically the EPA will be quite stringent

Legislative

- H.222 prior auth
- VDH is fine with the decriminalizes
- Advances the 6 steps of opioid settlement VDH fine with the drug testing component of the bill

Homeless Program

- the hotel/motel dwellers will have to find an alternative site
 - many will not have a place to go
- Little money to help public health impacts
